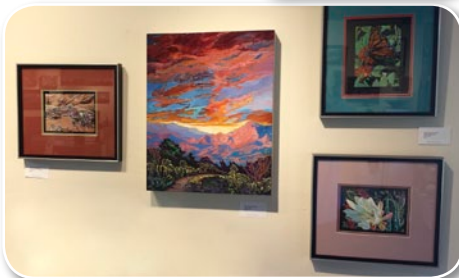

Justine's close friends and next door neighbors, Gwen and Pete Jones celebrated Pete's 75th birthday at girlfriend Donna Leavesley's home.



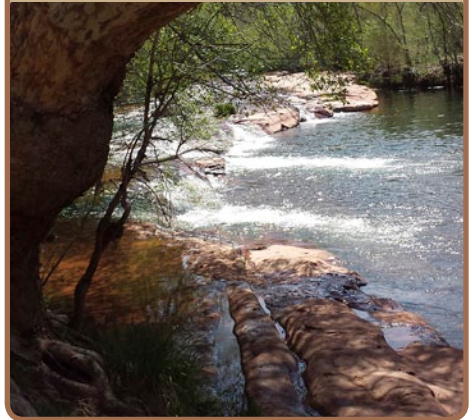
